

Waste that cannot be recycled such as broken porcelain and pottery, cigarette butts, ash from coal ovens, vacuum cleaner bags, toothbrushes, coat hangers, tights/pantyhose, disposable nappies/diapers, other hygiene items, broken toys, light bulbs, MCs/video cassettes.	Fruit and vegetable leftovers, stale and rotten food, egg shells, coffee grounds and filters, tea leaves and teabags, cut flowers, wood shavings, charcoal and ash, garden waste Organic waste bin: To maintain necessary hygiene standards, please use maize starch biodegradable bags	Tetrapack containers, plastic bottles for drinks, washing, cleaning and body care products, plastic lids, tops, containers, foil and tubes, packaging for soft drinks, coffee, vacuum and freezer packaging Composite materials e.g. packaging for pills Polystyrene/styrofoa m is collected separately.	All printed matter including newspapers, magazines, prospectuses, notebooks, circulars, brochures, books, writing paper, catalogues, window envelopes, uncoated and clean paper Cardboard (please fold): cartons and boxes, corrugated cardboard, kraft paper bags	Hollow glass containers such as bottles, flacons, food jars, cosmetics bottles, glass vials/ampules Please take care to separate clear and coloured glass and remove the tops. Be sure not to include any returnable bottles as they can be reused.	Tin cans for food and drinks, aluminium foil, bottle caps Paint and varnish tins should be emptied and scraped to prevent their contents from spilling or dripping out. Please place spray cans in the bin for hazardous waste.	Large electric appliances, such as dishwashers, fridges and freezers, TVs, computers and monitors Small electric and electronic appliances, such as toasters, mobile phones, hairdryers, shavers, radios, calculators, etc. Fluorescent lamps, energy-saving light bulbs/tubes, batteries for such devices	Used oil, batteries, nitro-cellulose and other solvents, cosmetics, paints and varnishes, mercury, disinfectants, photo chemicals, medicines, acids, alkaline or other caustic agents, e.g. paint stripper, etc. Please deposit used cooking oil and fat at the oil- collection point.	Residual waste that because of its size or shape can't be deposited in the non-recyclable waste bin, for example sofas, mattresses, carpets and other floor coverings, large plastic objects (children's bath tubs, tubes, etc.) large boxes and suitcases, curtain rails, sports equipment, skis, prams.

Waste that can be recycled! This includes waste paper, all packaging (glass, metal, cardboard, plastic), organic waste, old clothes and shoes, used electric and electronic devices.	Synthetic cat litter, vacuum cleaner bags, disposable nappies, cigarette butts, hazardous waste, non-recyclable waste, ash from coal ovens, packaging	Anything that is not packaging, e.g. broken toys, toothbrushes, coat hangers, tights/pantyhose, music and video cassettes, CDs	Carbon paper, cellophane, wallpaper, hygiene paper, paper tissues. These items go in the bin for non-recyclable waste.	Lids or caps, porcelain, earthenware bottles, ceramics, glass cutlery, drinking glasses, light bulbs, window panes, mirrors, wire glass	Composite materials, spray cans and gas cartridges, etc. that aren't completely empty. Pots, pans, bicycles or other scrap metal go in the scrap metal bin at the ASZ.	Toy train sets (rails, carriages), car- racing sets (tracks), CDs, MCs, video cassettes, toner cartridges	Empty paint and varnish containers, cleaning agents, etc. Such items go in the bin for packaging materials. 

Cardboard






- Cardboard boxes, wrapping paper, paper bags, cardboard, corrugated cardboard

→ • Please bring large boxes and cartons to the municipal recycling centre. Public containers should be packed tightly.



Clear glass and stained glass

free of charge



Exclusively packaging glass: e.g. disposable bottles (wine, champaign, juice), preserving iars (fruit, vegetables, jam)





- Public containers for clear and stained glass

no → • Window glass, glass crockery, dishes, mirror glass, wire glass, drinking glasses, china, earthenware, silex and bulbs, neon lights and energy saving lamps





- Please carefully separate clear glass from stained glass
- · Remove caps and lids from bottles and jars







Organic waste





- → Compostable kitchen waste: Vegetables, fruit and food leftovers, rotten food, coffee filters, tea bags, egg shells, soiled paper
- Yard waste: leaves, grass and brush, house and garden plant waste, weeds, pet litter





Into the bio-waste container

(napkins, tissues)

- Compost in your own garden
- Please dispose of tree prunings, hedge clippings and green refuse at the municipal recycling centre



free of charge






empty cups, glasses, jars, tubes, bags and wrappings of plastic, containers of juice or milk, composites, deep-feeze packages with coating





- Public container "Yellow Bin"
- Yellow bag
- Municipal recycling centre



Possibly reduce the volume (fold juice containers, press plastic bottles)







Metal packages

free of charge





→ • Exclusively packaging: aluminum cans and tins, pet food tins containers, metal tubes, metal caps or lids, lids of yoghurt containers, aluminum foil





- Public container "Blue Bin"
- Municipal recycling centre





no → Gas cartridges, fire extinguishers, aerosol cans with rest content (into the hazardous waste collection) other metal objects as nails, metal sheets, cooking pots (into the discarded metal)





Bulky waste



- → Trash that cannot be dumped into the residual waste because of it being too bulky or too heavy
- Separate materials like wood and metal from regular bulky waste like mattresses, carpets, floor covers, furniture



· All devices that are powered electrically. There are six categories for collection:

Large devices:

Washing machines, electric cookers, dishwashers

Small devices:

Cell phones, radios, mixers, vacuum cleaners, electronic tools

Monitors:

TVs, computer monitors

Cooling devices: Freezers, fridges, air conditionings

- Condenser discharge lamps: Neon lights and energy saving lamps
- Batteries




Hazardous waste

- Pesticides, chemicals
- · Household detergents, cleaning agents
- Paints, lacquers, adhesives
- Drugs
- · Oil-contaminated waste
- · Engine oil, heating oil, petrol
- Aerosol cans with residues
- Batteries and rechargeable batteries



- where ? -> Municipal recycling centre
 - · Problematic material collection



Caution → • Containers with dangerous residues should be disposed of as hazardous waste as well! Never mix various harmful substances and always hand in the original container!





Used cooking oils and edible fats into the Oil-bucket "Öli-Kübel"

free of charge



- → The oil-bucket "ÖLI" (available for free at the municipal collection site) helps you to dispose of:
- Used frying fat/oil and dripping
- Food oils (e.g. of cans and tins)
- Clarified or rendered butter as well as lard
- · Rotten edible oils and fats

Petroleums, engine oils, lubricants, mayonnaises, sauces, leftovers
